However, they do have a method to ask for donations, which is to have an individual call the main number (1-800-525-4267) and request. They are currently six months behind. The best times to call are January and July.

Purina encourages individual clients to call them directly and request discount coupons. Individuals can call every 4-6 weeks for coupons.

Lollipop's Senior Citizen Pet Assistance program has been changed to Veterinary Pet Assistance. There is a limited amount of money available for a vet exam, and then a little bit of money available for treatment (\$30-\$40). There is a food bank when there is food available; when their donations are greater than the animals they need to feed. Someone would need to pick up and drop off the food to a needy client.
